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# Please

Sometimes when we are worried about something it can be a bit like we are in a rocky boat or in a storm.

The anchor is the thing that stops the boat from floating away and keeps the passengers safe. In the Bible Jesus is described as an anchor and Christians believe he is with them in all the situations they face. Is there something you are worried about or afraid of?

**Write that thing on a piece of card (it can be in code). Use the stamp to put an anchor on your card and then put it in the boat as a way of thinking or praying about how you need help with that situation.**

There are lots of situations in the world where people are struggling.

Do you know of anything going on around the world? Have you heard about anything happening from the news?

**Think about something going on around the world that you would like to see changed. What positive thing would you like to happen in that situation? Write your thought or prayer onto a post-it-note and stick it to the bubble tube. Then spend some time watching the bubbles and fish.**

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# Sorry

Sometimes we are hurt by people. They may call us names or say or do things that are not nice.

When this happens we have a choice to forgive that person and let go of the hurts or to hold onto the anger and bitterness we may feel.

Christians believe that because God forgives them, it helps them to forgive other people.

**If you would like to, and feel you can, pick up a tablet, think about someone that you would like to forgive, and drop the tablet in the water.**

**As the tablet fizzes and gradually dissolves, think about letting go of the feelings you have towards that person and try to forgive them.**
